The courses are aimed at those persons with an interest in plants, gardening, herbalism, biodynamics, western esoteric traditions, integrative education and anyone interested in world wisdom traditions.

Jonathan's research and work crosses all the disciplines including plant alchemy, medicinal herbs, social development, plant phenomenology and holistic science through a practice based approach. He is Director of Crossfields Institute International and runs the Master's degree in Agroecology (researchingagroecology.org.uk) for Biodynamic Agriculture, Permaculture and other approaches. Jonathan is associated with the South African Biodynamic 2-year land based accredited training. He is a regular speaker at Waldorf Teachers conferences and is author of his book: Muck and Mind – Encountering Biodynamic Agriculture (Lindisfarne press)

The workshops Jonathan will be presenting arise from over a decade of his work in social and environmental education (Ruskin Mills) and continue to develop out of ongoing research into the synthesis of science, art and contemplative practice as a basis for education and social renewal.
